The Role

This is a good opportunity for a talented software developer looking to acquire experience of all aspects of the design and development of medium sized software applications.

You will work with the managing director and the consulting team to build a portfolio of software tools that automate internal processes and capture the company's intellectual property. This will include things like:

- Automating an assignment quality assurance and control process
- Creating mini-applications to standardise analyses of xml data extracts
- Modelling demand to derive the right capacity in a hospital
- Creating on-line tools that visitors to our web-site can use.

As well as developing software tools, you will be involved in supporting client projects and operational data analysis. This will likely include working with health service IT professionals to get them to create the data extracts you need to run your applications.

If you demonstrate the right flair and experience the role may be extended to include more direct interaction with clients eg. engaging with clinical staff to present your work and use it to help them implement effective solutions to operational issues.

Much of the job will be based at our offices in High Wycombe, Buckinghamshire but some time will be spent on client sites.

The normal hours of work are 0855 to 1805 although it is not uncommon for a consulting team to stay on site four days a week and to work between 0800 and 1900 hours.
